eBooks within EBSCOhost environment

- eBooks collection available in full integration with other EBSCO databases or in EBSCO Discovery Service
- Mobility
 - Possibility to copy to other devices (such as iPad, eReaders, smart phones,...)
- Available through already familiar interface of EBSCOhost
- **Print-out** option
- PermaLinks creation for an eBook title or a specific page

Access to a Book vs. eBook

Traditional library

- Read the book in the library

EBSCOhost

- Read the eBook online

Getting the full text home

- Make a xerox copy of any pages

- Export any portion for up to 60 pages into a PDF file

- Borrow the book

- Download (borrow) the eBook



- Via website of the institution





What is *EBSCO Discovery Service*?

- A single interface for discovery of a library's entire collection (electronic and print)
 - Journals
 - Magazines
 - Newspapers
 - Books
 - Library Catalog (OPAC)
 - Databases
 - Institutional Repositories

EDS: Why...

- Libraries & their content providers are competing with the “open web” for the attention of end users
- EDS was conceived and created in an attempt to help libraries & their content providers compete with Google (including Wikipedia) for the attention of students and even many faculty
- The need for a discovery service becomes abundantly clear when analyzing the perception of students:
- In a recent OCLC report: “College Student Perceptions” (<http://www.oclc.org/reports/perceptionscollege.htm>) they found that only 30% of college students used the library’s online resources



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
